

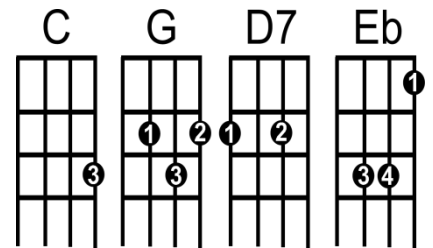
I SAW HER STANDING THERE - Lennon and McCartney 1963
