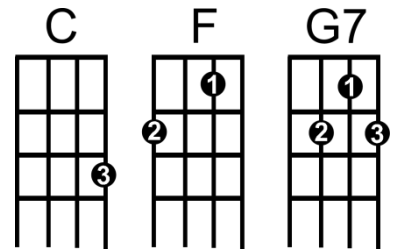


JAMAICA FAREWELL - Lord Burgess 1957
