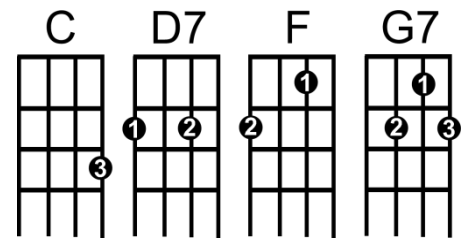


UKULELE LADY - Kahn / Whiting 1925
