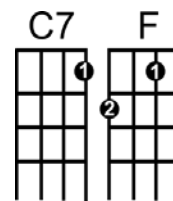


BUFFALO GALS - Traditional (published in 1844)

And we [C7] danced by the light of the [F] moon.

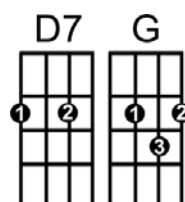


Chorus 1 [F] Buffalo Gals, won't you come out tonight

And we [C7] danced by the light of the [F] moon.

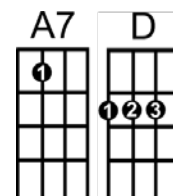
Repeat Chorus 1 [D7] (Key Change)
