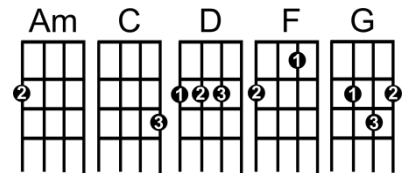


I'M THE URBAN SPACEMAN - Neil Innes 1968
