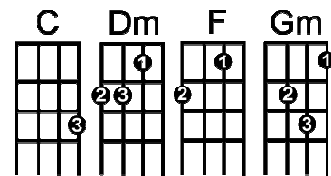


LOW BRIDGE - Thomas Allen 1913
