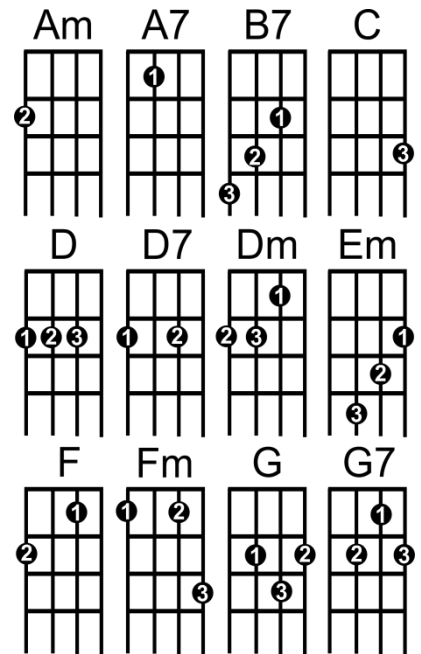


6 NATIONS MEDLEY - Various

[A7] Sure, they [D7] steal your [G7] heart a [C] way [G7]

Repeat whole song - then G7 - pause Ohhhh...

[n/c] Ma n'atu [C] sole, cchiù bello, [Dm] oje ne'. O sole [G7] mio, sta 'nfronte [C] a te
O [Fm] sole, O sole [C] mio, sta 'nfronte a [G7] te, sta 'nfronte a [C] te.

[n/c] It's now or [C] never, come hold me [Dm] tight,

Kiss me my [G7] darling, be mine to [C] night

To [Fm] morrow will be too [C] late, it's now or [G7] never, my love won't [C] wait.

[n/c] Just one Cor[C]netto, give it to [Dm] me, delicious [G7] ice-cream from [C] Italy
Its [Fm] taste is just [C] supreme give me [G7] Cornetto from Wall's ice [C] cream
Give me [G7] Cornetto from Wall's ice [C] cream [F C] *big finish [G7] - pause*

By [C] yon bonnie [Am] banks and [F] by yon bonnie [G] braes,
[C] Where the sun shines [Am] bright on Loch [F] Lo [G] mond,
[F] There me and my [C] true love spent [F] many happy [G] days
[C] On the bonnie, bonnie [F] banks o' Loch [G] Lo...[C]mond.

[C] Oh, ye'll take the [Am] high road, and [F] I'll take the [G] low road

[C] And I'll be in [Am] Scotland [F] before [G] ye

[F] But me and my [C] true love will [F] never meet [G] again

On the [C] bonnie, bonnie [F] banks o' Loch [G] Lo...[C]mond. repeat chorus

G7 - *slow right down then pause...*

1. [n/c] There'll be [C] bluebirds [Em] over the [F] white cliffs of [C] Dover
[Dm] Tomorrow [G] just you [G7] wait and [C] see [G7]

[Dm] Tomorrow [G] when the [G7] world is [C] free

The [F] shepherd will tend his sheep, the [C] valley will bloom again

And [F] Jimmy will go to sleep (slow) in his [D] own little [D7] room [G7] again

3. [n/c] There'll be [C] bluebirds [Em] over the [F] white cliffs of [C] Dover
[Dm] Tomorrow [G] just you [G7] wait and [C] see [G7]
