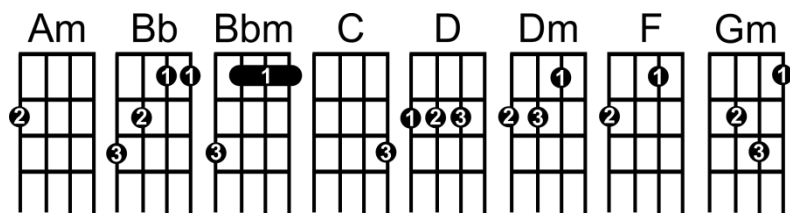


SMILE - Chaplin / Turner / Parsons 1936/1954
