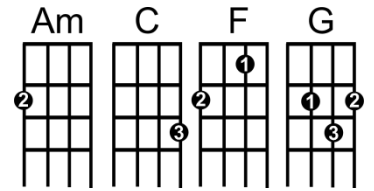


STAND BY ME - Ben E. King 1961
