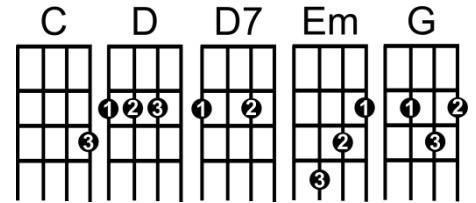


TAKE ME HOME, COUNTRY ROADS - John Denver 1971
