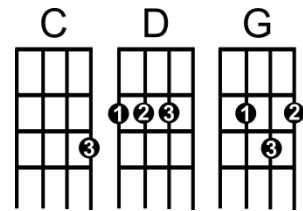


WEREWOLVES OF LONDON - Marinell, Wachtel, Zevon 1978
