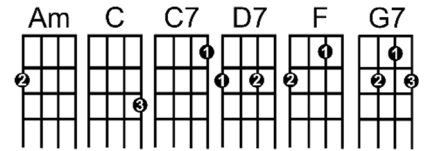


BABY'S IN BLACK - Lennon & McCartney 1964
