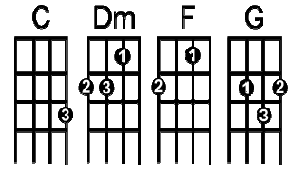


CAN'T HELP MYSELF - Holland / Dozier / Holland, 1965
