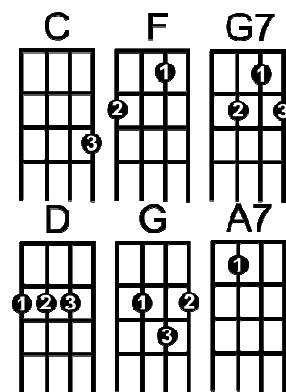


DA DOO RON RON - Barry / Greenwich / Spector 1963

Intro: C F G7 C (1st 2 lines)
