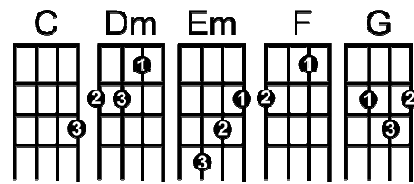


ONE MORE NIGHT - Bob Dylan 1969

C **Em** **F** **G**
