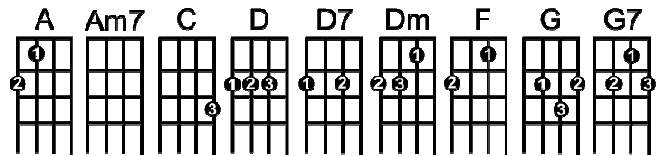


WATERLOO SUNSET - Ray Davies 1967
