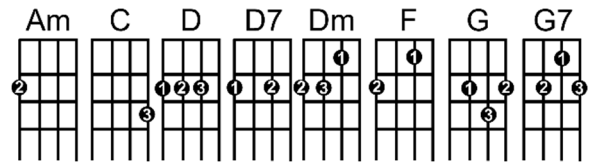


BLUE MOON – Rogers and Hart 1934
