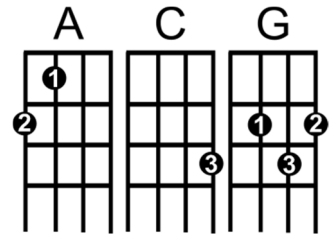


YOU CAN'T ALWAYS GET WHAT YOU WANT – Jagger/Richards 1969
